When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area. 2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00. PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing at least 24 hours advance notice. The inspector will need the **job location and permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**

***Contractor/Owner that pulls permit for grinder/sewer shall call DPW prior to calling for electrical inspection.**
